ARROW WOOD TURNING MAPLE BURL RECEIVES COMPETITION AWARD

The Sandwich Fair Awards Artist Nicholas Moore

TUFTONBORO, NH – October 28, 2017 – A Maple Burl created by Nicholas Moore at Arrow Wood Turning was awarded second place in the 2017 Sandwich Fair. Held annually on Columbus Day weekend since 1910, the Sandwich Fair includes competitions of works created by local artists.

The piece entered by Arrow Wood Turning was turned and hollowed by Nicholas Moore in July 2017 in his Tuftonboro studio. The wood was a local New Hampshire Maple Burl. It showcases a stunning maple grain pattern, contains several natural voids, and retains the natural edge bark. It measures 21” in length and given its unique shape was named “The Butterfly Bowl”.

“It is truly an honor for this piece to receive such recognition,” states artist Nicholas Moore. “I grew up attending The Sandwich Fair, so to have the opportunity to submit a piece of my art and to receive a second-place award is particularly special”.

The Butterfly Bowl is now part of a private collection.
